My constituents would like to see the government adopt the following charter:

1. Speedy access to specialists for everyone referred by their GP
2. Instant information for those newly diagnosed
3. Parkinson's passport which gives patients an automatic right to certain benefits, such as a "blue badge" and free prescriptions.
4. Comprehensive care, including a personal plan for accessing interdisciplinary support.
5. Quest for a cure. The government should commit to a major increase for research into Parkinson's.
